

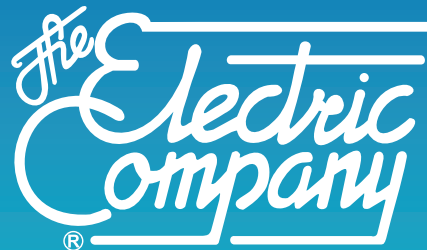
HOW DO YOU GET STARTED?

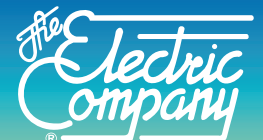

AIR INFILTRATION: Seal, caulk and weatherstrip your home to reduce air leaks.

CEILING/WALL INSULATION: If your home isn't properly insulated, chances are much of that cold and warm air is escaping your home and taking your money with it.

DUCT SEALING: Seal leaks and holes and properly connect ducts to reduce energy waste.

COOL ROOFS: High-efficiency roofing materials reflect solar heat instead of allowing it to be absorbed into your building.

ENERGY STAR® CERTIFIED POOL PUMPS: High-efficiency pool pumps are designed to save energy. ***Rebate is available.*

ENERGY STAR CERTIFIED WINDOWS & SLIDING GLASS DOORS: Install efficient windows and sliding glass doors to stop cold drafts and hot air from entering your home.

EVAPORATIVE COOLERS: In hot, dry climates installing evaporative cooling is a cost-effective and energy-efficient way to cool your home. ***Rebate is available.*

SOLAR SCREENS: Solar screens installed on south- or west-facing windows or glass doors block at least 65% of the solar heat gain.

REFRIGERATED AIR: A high efficiency refrigerated air conditioner or mini-split can provide greater energy savings. ***Rebates for refrigerated air only apply to qualifying units purchased AND installed by Home Depot/Lowe's third party contractor*

WATER HEATER PIPE INSULATION: Insulating the pipes and tank of an electric water heater prevents heat loss.

HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER: These water heaters use 70% less electricity than a standard electric model.
