

HOW DO YOU GET STARTED?

Texas residential customers are eligible for rebates when they participate in El Paso Electric's energy efficiency programs.*


- 1 Select the energy efficiency home improvement project you are interested in.
- 2 Select a Contractor of your choice or contact a Participating Contractor. Customers may also elect to pursue most rebates without the help of a contractor -download the rebate application to see minimum requirements. *All refrigerated cooling systems must be installed by a licensed HVAC contractor to be eligible.
- 3 The contractor you select will see if you qualify for greater rebates through the Income Qualified Energy Efficiency Program.
- 4 If you choose to work with a Participating Contractor, incentives will be shown on the invoice the contractor provides you. You receive the rebate instantly!

Evaporative Cooler Eligibility List



AIR INFILTRATION: Seal, caulk and weatherstrip your home to reduce air leaks.

CEILING/WALL INSULATION: If your home isn't properly insulated, chances are much of that cold and warm air is escaping your home and taking your money with it.

DUCT SEALING: Seal leaks and holes and properly connect ducts to reduce energy waste.

COOL ROOFS: High-efficiency roofing materials reflect solar heat instead of allowing it to be absorbed into your building.

ENERGY STAR® CERTIFIED POOL PUMPS: High-efficiency pool pumps are designed to save energy.

ENERGY STAR CERTIFIED WINDOWS & SLIDING GLASS DOORS: Install efficient windows and sliding glass doors to stop cold drafts and hot air from entering your home.

EVAPORATIVE COOLERS: In hot, dry climates, installing evaporative cooling is a cost-effective and energy-efficient way to cool your home.

SOLAR SCREENS: Solar screens installed on south- or west-facing windows or glass doors block at least 65% of the solar heat gain.

REFRIGERATED AIR: A high-efficiency refrigerated air conditioner or mini-split can provide greater energy savings.

**Rebates for refrigerated air only apply to qualifying units installed by a certified HVAC Contractor.*

WATER HEATER PIPE INSULATION: Insulating the pipes and tank of an electric water heater prevents heat loss.

HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER: These water heaters use 70% less electricity than a standard electric model.

ENERGY STAR CERTIFIED SMART THERMOSTATS: Save energy with reliable performance, convenience and comfort.

ENERGY STAR WINDOW AIR CONDITIONER: High-efficiency window units can help you save energy and allow you to control temperature in individual rooms.
